

Dowling wins state hockey championship

Dowling became the first Des Moines team to win the state high school hockey championship when it posted a 3-1 victory Sunday over Waterloo at the Des Moines Ice Arena.

Goalie Frank Cataldo had 36 saves and Andy Lyons scored two goals for Dowling.

In other games Sunday, Columbus of Waterloo whipped Valley, 4-2, for third place; Urbandale defeated Roosevelt-Hoover, 3-1, for fifth, and Ankeny took a 6-5 match from Sioux City for seventh.

Named to the first all-state team were goalie Eric Petersen of Waterloo; defensemen Mike Hoshaw of Valley and Brent Hartman of Sioux City, and forwards Clay Wiffen of Sioux City, Rick Radcliff of Valley and Barney Munro of Dowling.
