Waterloo Public, which won the league title, faces Ankeny Friday night at 7 p.m.

Defending state champion Columbus High of Waterloo plays Urbandale at 7 p.m. Thursday in the tourney's first game.

The winners of those two contests will meet in a Saturday night semifinal.

Ankeny had to defeat Mason City, the division II champion, to gain a berth in the state tournament. Ankeny finished last in the division II standings.

The tournament has losers' bracket games scheduled for 1 and 3:30 p.m. Saturday. The championship semis are scheduled for 6:30 and 8:30 Saturday night.

The tournament concludes with four games Sunday.

The 4:30 p.m. championship game will be preceded by a game for seventh place at 9 a.m., a fifth place game at 11:30 a.m. and a third place game at 2 p.m.
