

Columbus wins hockey crown

Columbus of Waterloo claimed its second consecutive state high school hockey championship Sunday with a 6-4 victory over Valley of West Des Moines at the Des Moines Ice Arena.

Scott Dolan, Bryan Trowbridge and Brian Kietly each scored two goals for Columbus (18-1), which won the league title for the fifth time in the past seven years.

Valley's goals were scored by Steve Miller, Todd Gifford, Keith Armstrong and Randy Watkins.

In the consolation game, Scott Cross' four goals lifted Urbandale past Waterloo, 8-2, as Urbandale goaltender Larry Young recorded 52 saves.

Hoover-Roosevelt of Des Moines defeated Mason City, 5-4, for fifth place, and Bob Brewer scored in overtime to give Dowling of West Des Moines a 7-6 triumph over Ames for seventh.
