## Metros head for Des Moines

Sioux City's Metro high school hockey team will begin its 1981-82 season this weekend with a two-day

road trip to Des Moines.

Coach Walt Johnson's Metros will open Friday with West Des Moines Valley at 8:30 p.m., then follow with a 6:30 game Saturday evening with Urbandale. Both games will be played at the Des Moines Ice Arena.
