

Metros name two former Musketeers as coaches

Two former Sioux City Musketeers, Barry Head and Dave LeGree, have been named coaches for the Sioux City Metros high school hockey team.

Head was a center for the 1973-74 Musketeers and ranks seventh in career scoring for the United States Hockey League team. LeGree was a goalie for the Musketeers in 1977-79 and served as interim head coach of the team for a portion of the 1980-81 campaign. He also played a season with the Milwaukee Admirals of the International Hockey League.

Last year, Head and LeGree worked together as coaches for the Siouxland Youth Hockey Association Bantam (13-14) team.

The Metros begin practice this month and will open their season at the new ice arena in South Sioux City against Waterloo Public Nov. 13.

Registration for the Metros, as well as for other youth hockey divisions, will be from 3-6 p.m. Sunday at the ice arena in South Sioux.
