the puck into the net from 10 feet out. Just 56 seconds into the third period Dolan scored his hat trick as he skated down on Majetich, who froze as Dolan skated in front of him and easily put the puck in the net.

Freshman Todd Armstrong scored twice for Urbandale while Lanigan and Grant Weidner each got a goal for the Sailors in the third period.
