

# Columbus, Warriors win openers

MASON CITY — Brandon Bunger scored his second goal of the game 10:22 into an overtime period to give the Waterloo Warriors a 4-3 first round victory over Urbandale at the state high school hockey tournament Friday.

Friday evening, top-seeded Columbus of Waterloo, the Iowa High School Hockey League champion, defeated Urbandale, 8-1. The loss eliminated Urbandale from the double-elimination tournament. It had lost to Sioux City, 6-3, in an earlier first round game.

Valley-Dowling of West Des Moines defeated host Mason City, 5-3, in the other game opening day and was paired against Columbus Saturday. Sioux City and the Warriors met in the other semifinal.

Brian Wehr scored two goals and had four assists and Neal Lanigan had two goals and two assists as the Sailors rolled to their victory. They limited Urbandale to eight shots in the final two periods after taking a 3-1 first period lead.

Ames battled back from a 3-0 deficit to tie the Warriors on a goal by Brian Martinson with 16 seconds left in regulation.

The Warriors led 3-0 after two periods on goals by Tomas Conradi, Chad McFarland and Bunger.
