

Metro icers face nemesis Ames at state

DUBUQUE, Iowa — The Sioux City Metros have won 22 hockey games this season.

None of the 22 are against Ames, however; the foe today (12:30 p.m.) in the semifinals of the 1994 Iowa High School Hockey League post-season tournament.

Ames has beaten Sioux City twice this season, each time in the first two weeks of the season, 7-6 and 7-3.

The Metros advanced to the tournament semis Friday with a 9-2 win over Dubuque and Ames tripped Mason City, 4-3.

Ten different players scored points for the top-seeded Metros in their Friday win.

Mark Doren paced the offensive onslaught with a four-goal game.

Mikael Sundelin, the leading scorer on the squad with 60 points, added two goals and three assists, while Sam Kincaid, Seth Schramm and Mike Stoneburg collected goals for Coach Jim Peck's Metros.

Sioux City improved its record to 22-6 and Dubuque slumped to 2-22. The host Devils, seeded ninth in the tournament, earned the right to face the Metros with a 5-2 win over eighth-seeded St. Joseph, Mo., Thursday night in the Five Flags Center here.

In other games Friday, the Omaha Gladiators shut out the Omaha Junior Lancers, 1-0, and West Des Moines Valley-Dowling edged Waterloo, 4-2.

Valley-Dowling is the defending tournament champion and is seeded second behind the Metros.

Ames, the Sioux City foe today, hiked its record to 17-6 in beating Mason City Friday.
