

Warriors fall, will play for seventh

DES MOINES — The third-seeded Des Moines Capitals scored a key goal 4 minutes, 12 seconds into the third period to pull away from Waterloo for a 5-2 victory in the consolation bracket of the Iowa High School Hockey League tournament Saturday.

The Capitals, 25-5-2 during the regular season, built a 2-0 lead with a goal just 50 seconds into the contest and a power-play tally early in the second period.

Jacob Irey cut the deficit in half with a goal for the Warriors 9:22 into the second, but the Caps made it 3-1 just two minutes later.
