"Kansas City had us down 4-1 midway through the second period but then had some bad penalties and we were able to rally and pick it up," said Blues

coach Nick White.

The team's leading scorer Kendall Price (Riverdale High School) had a hat trick, while second-line players — Bennett Welser (Moline), Brad Teplicky (Bettendorf) and Drew Taylor (Davenport Central) — helped rally the Blues, according to White.

Josh Prygon (Galesburg), Taylor, Collin DeBuysere (Geneseo) and Jeff Morris (Bettendorf) each added a goal for the Blues. Morris had three assists.

White also credited the play by the Blues goalie, Reed Festing-Smith (Bettendorf), who stopped 29 of 33 shots.

"Reed shut them down after they went up 4-1. Then our team really rallied around Reed, and I think Kansas City was shocked with our comeback and really didn't have an answer after the second period."
