

Mohawks place 4th at state tournament

AMES — A day after falling in overtime to the top-seeded Des Moines Capitals in the semifinals of the Midwest High School Hockey League tournament, the Mason City Hockey Club fell to the Kansas City Stars 4-2 in the third-place game.

The Stars' Alex Williamson netted a hat trick in the first period as Kansas City took a 3-0 lead into the first intermission.

In the second period, Clint Hain put the Mohawks on the board with an assist from Mitch Hain.

The Mohawks' Justin Metli added a goal in the third period to cut the Stars' lead to 3-2 5 minutes, 18 seconds into the third before Kansas City's Matt Curry added the final goal of the game.

Mason City ended the season at 25-7-0-3.
