

# Warriors cruise into MHSHL semis

AMES — Waterloo unloaded on Kansas City early and raced past the Jets 8-3 in the opening round of the Midwest High School Hockey League tournament Friday.

Cade Saeugling got the Warriors started with a power-play goal just 1 minute, 50 seconds into the game. Kyle Schott added another man-advantage score at the 13-minute mark and tacked on two goals in the final minute of

the period to send Waterloo into intermission with a 4-1 lead.

Kansas City got within 4-2 in the second period, but Schott's fourth goal of the day and a tally by Nick Samuelson made it 6-2. Saeugling and Drew Westphal capped the Warriors' scoring with third-period goals.

Schott finished the day with four goals and three assists, while Dawson Sturch had 25 saves in goal.

Waterloo (22-7-0-0) advanced to a noon semifinal Saturday against No. 2 seed Omaha (24-4-1-0).
